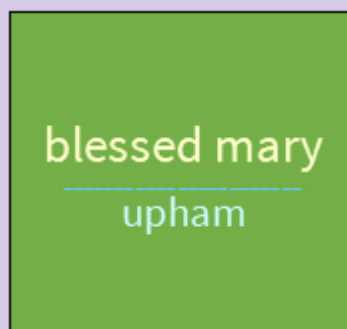
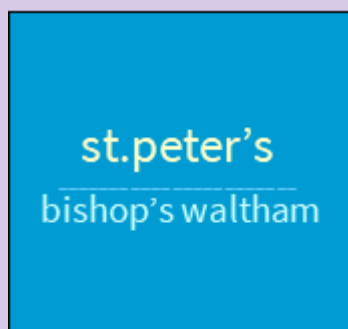


## St Peter's and Blessed Mary Sunday 29th September
